Gentlemen:

Eagle Oil & Gas Co. is the operator of the above captioned well and has been notified by Mr. W. A. Gressett, Supervisor, District II, of a need to file an application for a non-standard unit in accordance with Division Rule 104 D II. Our well is located on the west one-half of Section 30 and comprises all of the west one-half of that section. According to my understanding of this rule we would be allowed administrative approval of this location due to it being necessitated by variation in the legal subdivision of the U. S. Public Land Surveys. We, as operators, have not modified this drilling unit in any way, but have included all acreage in the west half of Section 30 into our proration unit for this well.

If this data is correct and does meet the rules as outlined under 104 D II, would you please issue us administrative approval for a non-standard gas unit for the Morrow Formation for the above described well.
