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operations. As a result of this non-controllable gas entering El Paso's system, the gas takes from other prorated, non-prorated and non-marginal gas wells must be incrementally reduced.

Please be advised that the South Empire State Com No. 1 Well may, or may not, be shut-in once it has been placed back to normal scheduling. El Paso's market demand will dictate such course of action.
