We are attaching a copy of Jake L. Hamon's letter of March 16, 1981, transmitting Form C-105, Well Completion Report and log showing completion of subject well as a dry hole in March of 1981.

The intent of this letter is to advise you of a change in the status of the well. Riverside Co-op of Artesia, New Mexico, wishes to re-enter the abandoned wellbore and convert it to a fresh water source well.
