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

Dear Mr. Gressett:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of this date, we should like to set out the following:

- (1) At no time since the completion of this well, have we flared any gas and the only gas we have used is a small amount to run a stationary engine that furnished the power to run the pump jack.
- (2) Practically all of the gas that has been produced with the oil has gone down the flow line to the heater-treater located at the tank battery.
- (3) At the point of the tank battery, the heater-treater separates the oil from the gas. At the same spot the gas is put into the pipeline of Phillips Petroleum, the purchaser of the casinghead gas.
- (4) Due to the fact that no gas whatsoever has been wasted at this well, we ask that you reinstate the allowable and make it effective as of July 16, 1981, the date upon which your order was effective.
