This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describhe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

## 1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit 3 and 3A is a portion of a county road map and a USGS map showing the well and roads in the vicinty of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 14 miles northeast of Artesia, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in pink and yellow.

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Go east of Artesia on Highway 82 for 14 1/2 miles.
- 2. Turn north on Eddy County Road #209 for 6 1/2 miles.
- 3. New road starts here.

## 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.

- A. The proposed new access road will be approximately 3470' in length from the point of origin to the northeast edge of the drilling pad. The road will lie in a east to west direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on one side. Some traffic turnouts will be built.
- D. The route of the road is visible and has been flagged.
- E. Existing roads will be maintained in the same or better condition.
