Some wells in the area have experienced some problems with lost circulation. Adequate supplies of LCM should be on location.

## VI. MUD LOGGING:

A. Mud Logger:	Mud logger should be rigged up and logging at 8000 ft. The Mud Logging contractor has not been selected as yet.
B. Samples:	Wash and bag 10 ft samples from 1800ft to TD.

## VII. OPEN HOLE LOGGING PROGRAM:

G/R, Neutron, 0 to TD. SP, DIL, LDL, approximately 8500 ft to TD. Microlog may be run over intervals selected by geologist.

The open hole logger has not yet been selected.
