Dear Mr. Carr:

Reference is made to your application dated September 14, 1998 on behalf of the operator, Enron Oil & Gas Company, for an unorthodox Morrow gas well location for its proposed Sabres "19" Federal Com. Well No. 1 to be drilled 1846 feet from the North line and 926 feet from the West line (Unit F) of irregular Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Lots 1 through 4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 19, being a standard 252.16-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Morrow formation, is to be dedicated to this well.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division").

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
