**Corrected Administrative Order NSL-4375** 

Dear Mr. Morgan:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated October 25, 1999; and (ii) the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") records in Santa Fe: all concerning SDX Resources, Inc.'s ("SDX") request for an unorthodox oil well location within a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Artesia-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.
