Mr. Foppiano,

I am writing this e-mail to explain the "Engineering Bureau" policy for reviewing administrative orders and how this effects your application (pKRV0-221135459) for the Sweet & Sour State Well No. 6.

When an application is received, the assigned examiner has certain time constraints in place for conducting a review. Depending on the review other time constraints are then applied against the examiner for approving, denying, or completing the application. In this case where additional information is required the applicant is initially given up to seven days to submit the required information. At the end of this initial seven day period and, if time allows, the applicant is reminded that an incomplete application cannot be approved. If, after 30 days from the date the application is initially received by the Division, the application is still incomplete, the reviewer is to return the application. This 30-day deadline for your application is August 28, 2002; therefore, there is still ample time for OXY to submit the requested information to complete this application.

I will hold this subject application until Aug. 28th, that way you will be assured a timely order from the Division provided OXY meets with the necessary requirements. I hope this provides you with additional enlightenment concerning our review procedures and policy.
