Dear Mr. Foppiano:

Within the 30-day period commencing July 29, 2002, I sent: (i) the Division's initial response to your application by letter dated July 31, 2002 requesting additional information to support OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership's ("OXY") above-described application; (ii) a second letter dated August 8, 2002 as a reminder that the requested data had not been received; and (iii) an e-mail of August 13, 2002 explaining the Engineering Bureau's policy for reviewing administrative orders and an additional reminder that ample time remained for OXY to submit the requested data. As policy dictates, enclosed for your convenience are copies of these three written notices.

To date OXY has not submitted the needed supplemental data necessary to complete your application; therefore, this application is deemed incomplete and in order to fully comply with our policy, your application ereby **denied**. I am returning it to you at this time.
