3. Estimated Depths of Anticipated Fresh Water, Oil or Gas

The estimated depths at which water, oil and gas will be encountered are as follows.

Water: None expected in area

Gas: Morrow @ 8,200' – 8,400'

No other formations are expected to yield oil, gas or fresh water in measurable volumes. The surface fresh water sands will be protected by setting 8 5/8" casing at 1400' and circulating cement back to surface. The oil and gas intervals will be isolated by setting 5 1/2" casing at TD and bringing cement top to approximately 6000'.
