DETAILS OF WORK

 well will be drilled with 5 1/2" pipe. It is expected that the total depth will be about 2750' and a string of 5 1/2" pipe will be run to total depth, cemented with 100 sacks of cement, the plan then is to perforate two zones which is anticipated at about 2528' and about 2660', two zones being what is commonly known as Loco Hills and Premier. If above works out accordingly to plans electric log will be run, the two zones perforated and treated with oil sand frac.
