## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We plan to fill hole with mud to 2350 and set cement plug of 5 sacks. Then knock off 7" casing at approximately 2000' and pull same. Then fill hole with mud to 1855 and set second cement plug of 5 sacks, - then knock off 10" casing at approximately 300' and pull same. Then fill hole with mud to 350' and set third cement plug of 5 sacks, - then fill hole with mud to surface and set regulation marker.

It is our intention to recover approximately 2000' of 7" casing and approximately 300' of 10" casing
