DETAILS OF WORK

On February 6, 1957 we ran 266' of 8 5/8" OD 8rd thrd used seamless casing to 272' and cemented with 50 max cement.

After allowing to stand cemented 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole dry and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling operations were resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Co.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
