DETAILS OF WORK

On Sept. 24, 1956 we ran 2346' of 7" OD casing (67 lbs. HS 20F & 1 ft. of HS 26F) to 2350' and cemented with 200 sac Alamo cement. After allowing to stand 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
