Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On February 19, 1956 we ran 311 ft of 8 5/8" casing in this well to shut off water we had encountered at 90 ft. Then on April 9, 1956 we ran 2425 ft. of 5 1/2" casing and cemented with 150 sacks of cement and 1,000 lbs. of aquagel. After waiting 72 hours for the cement to set we swabbed the hole dry and tests showed a complete water shut off. The cement was pumped down to 2412 ft. We are preparing to perforate and treat well.
