Propose to fill hole with mud from 2500' TD to 2260 set cement plug of five sacks; then fill with mud to 2125 and set cement Plug of five sacks; then fill hole with mud to surface and erect regulation marker. Propose pulling 8" set at 363 - there is no water behind the 8".

Will set bridge for each plug.
