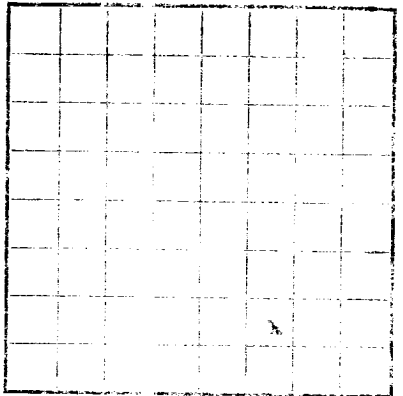

Dilled 8" hole to 24.5 and set 5 1/2" casing. Drilled to 24.6' and free open hole section 15,000 gal. 15,000' sand. No return. Set plug at 24.8', port. Metex sand 2362-75, 2384-86, and 2396-2400'. Frac 15,000 gas oil and 15,000# sand. Potentiated well from upper zone only.

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked," or left in the well, give its size and location.
