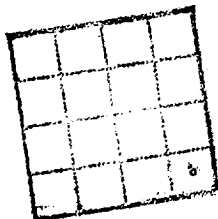

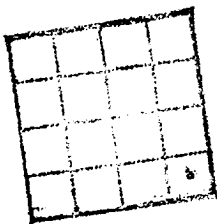

### DETAILS OF WORK

This well was plugged per report dated 1-15-51 as follows:

On 1-29-51 we mudded the hole from TD (2553) to 2410 and set a 10 sack cement plug (2410 to 2385). The 7" casing was set at 2391 feet. On 2-1-51 we knocked the 7" casing off at 1252' 10" and pulled same, mudded the hole from 2385 to 1165 and set a 10 sack cement plug (1165 to 1135). On 2-3-51 we mudded the hole from 1135 to 490 and set a 10 sack cement plug (490 to 470). We knocked off the 8" casing at 210 feet and pulled same. The 8" casing was set at 480 feet. Then we mudded the hole 470 to surface, cemented cellar, set regulation marker and cleaned up the location.

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I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
