I note that your Dodd "A", No. 13 Well, located in the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 15-17S-29E, which was completed March 22, 1956, with top of pay at 3235', is outside of the present designated boundary of the Grayburg-Keely Pool.

Please find enclosed herewith Form C-123, Request for Pool Extension, which we will appreciate your completing these forms in triplicate and returning to this office. Since you have a well drilled in the SW/SE of this section and is projected to the Grayburg-Keely zone, I would suggest that you ask for the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 15 to be included in the Grayburg-Keely Pool.

We further request that you file an additional Form C-123 in triplicate requesting extension of the Grayburg-Jackson Pool to include your Dodd "A" No. 16 Well in NE/SE of Section 15-17S-29E, completed April 16, 1956, with top of pay at 2404'.
