DETAILS OF WORK

This location was moved 237' east in order to provide a full 40 acre proration unit.

We propose to drill this well with a rotary rig to test the Queen Sand at approximately 1600'. We plan to set 7" 20# seamless casing at 4 3/4' and cement w/50 sxs. in a 6 3/4" hole, then drill ahead in a 6 1/4" hole to total depth. We anticipate coring 60' in the Seven Rivers formation from 880' to 940' and in the Queen Sand at 1600'.

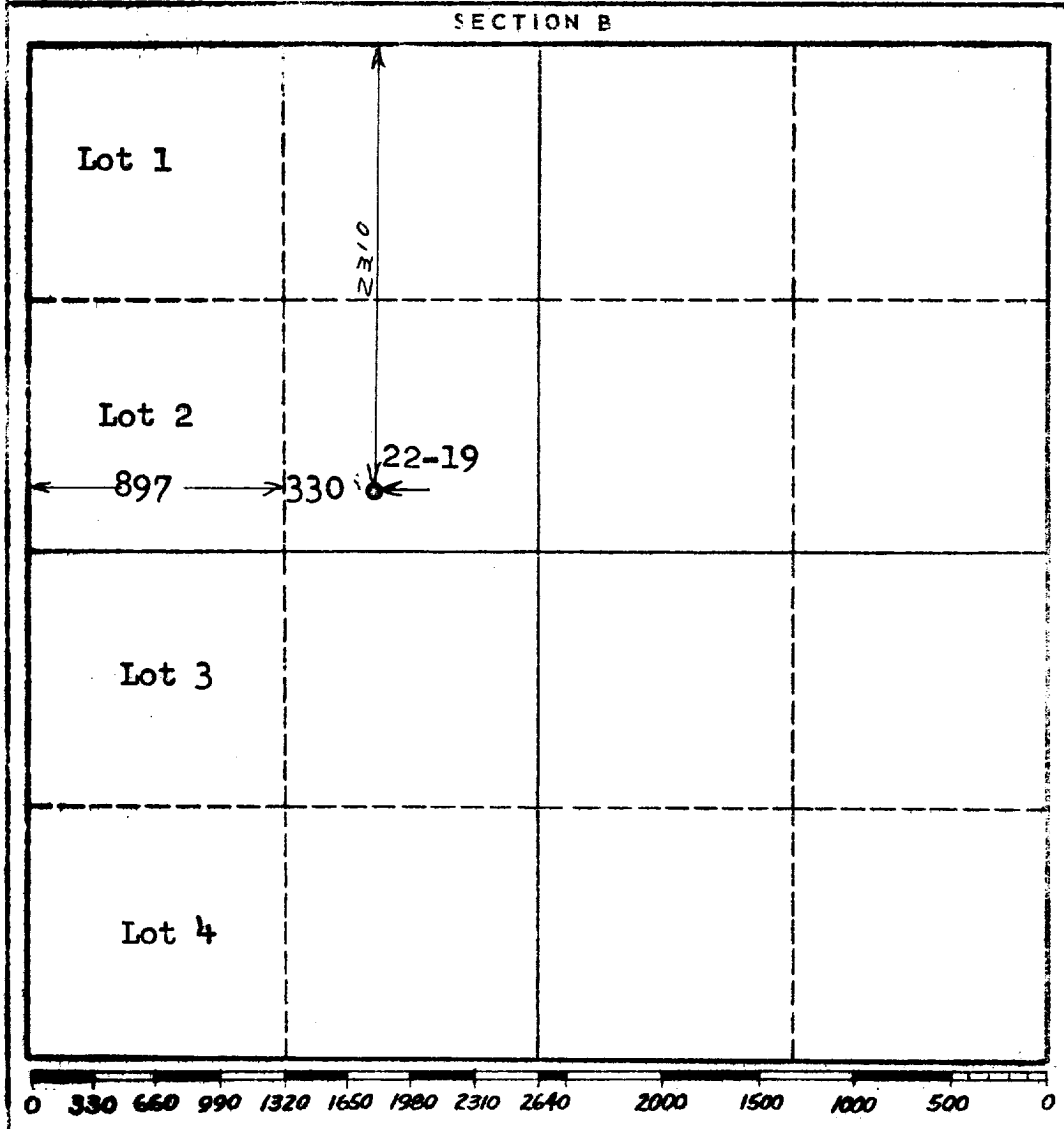
