DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to set 8 5/8" surface casing at approximately 400' and cement to surface with 300 sacks cement.

We propose to drill to the Grayburg-Isaly Zone at approximately 3275'. Set 5 1/2" casing on top of zone and cement with 250 sacks with 4% gel.

We propose to sand - oil free open hole section below 5 1/2" casing during the completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
