

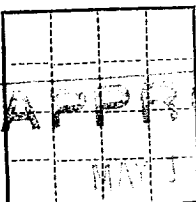

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3600 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On April 29, 1957 we ran 744' (23 joints) of 5 1/2" OD lined 14' & 13.5' JS casing as liner hung on Brown Type "C" 6-clip liner hanger & Type "T" packer (16"). Total length 760', hung from 2505' to 3265' and cemented with 35 sacks cement.

After allowing to stand 16 hours, we ran temperature survey which indicated top of cement at 2810'.

After standing cemented 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole dry and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling operations were resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

Temperature survey was run by West Engineering Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
