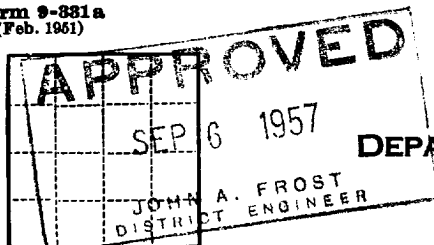

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3579 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

On August 22, 1957 we ran 599' of 5 1/2" OD 17# 8rd third new JS casing as liner hung on Brown Type "C" 6-slip liner hanger and Type "F" packer (16"). Total length 599' hung from 2860' to 3267' and cemented with 35 sacks cement.

After standing cemented for 17 hours we ran temperature survey which indicated top of cement at 2860'.

After allowing to stand cemented for 72 hours we drilled plug, bailed hole dry and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Danton Oil Well Cementing Company.

Temperature survey was run by West Engineering Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operation may be commenced.
