

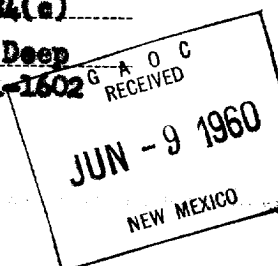

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilling operations commenced May 26, 1960.

On May 29, 1960 we ran 1386' of 8 5/8" OD 8rd thrd 28# used MS casing to 1404' and cemented with 375 sacks containing 7200# NaCl and 150 sacks containing 2% CaCl₂. After standing for 27 hours, we pressured up on casing to 1000 psig. We then drilled plug and pressured up on cement to 1000 psig. Pressure test proved OK and drilling operations were resumed.

Cementing was done by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company.
