Well History

The Grayburg Deep Unit Well No. 5 was drilled in 1960 by General American Oil Company of Texas. Records indicate that after perforating and testing, the well was temporarily abandoned pending possible salt water disposal service or testing of the Morrow formation.

Phillips Petroleum Company aquired the Grayburg Deep Unit in 1983 upon buying General American Oil Company. In 1985 Phillips installed pumping equipment. After pumping for a short period of time it was returned to a shut-in status.

In August, 1990 pumping equipment was again installed and the well was returned to production.

There is no record of completion reports or logs being filed with the Bureau of Land Management or the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
