

PLEASE READ BEFORE STARTING OPERATIONS

Because suspension of field operations will be required by the District Engineer for failure to comply with the Operating Regulations and the conditions of drilling approval, particular attention is called to those general and special requirements most likely to be overlooked by the operator:

GENERAL

1. All drilling and producing wells and pits permanently marked in a conspicuous place with the name of the owner, lease name, well number, and location. Necessary precautions must be taken to protect well signs.

2. Any desired suspension of drilling operations and suspension of approval must have the written approval of the District Engineer. No work shall be done until the suspension is made.

3. Production restrictions shall be made at the time of drilling and completion made with a reasonable gas-oil ratio.

4. Before starting drilling, written approval must be obtained and after work is done, the District Engineer must be notified by the D. E. of the completion of the survey by submission of a report of completion of the well, including the following:

- a. Location of the well, the name of the owner, and the method of access to the well.
- b. Drilling and completion logs.
- c. Location of the well, the name of the owner, and the method of access to the well.

5. A written report of completion, including the name of the well, must be submitted promptly to the District Engineer. After completion of the first well on a permit or lease and production shall be made at the discretion of the District Engineer and producing operations.

6. If, in the event, a new well is drilled, it must be submitted within 10 days of completion of the well to the District Engineer. Copies of all electrical logs, casing logs, and completion logs, and all other well information not given or the production logs, shall be submitted to the District Engineer.

7. If a new well is drilled on a well on Federal land is required, and the District Engineer shall be notified of the completion of the well having a desirable completion.

PRODUCTION RESTRICTIONS

1. This notice is approved subject to the condition that drilling operations so authorized shall be in conformity with the terms and conditions of Petroleum Administrative Order No. 11 (formerly WPC Conservation Order M-66) or any modification or amendment thereof that hereafter may be issued.

2. An electrical log is required on this well from the 7" casing shoe to the total depth.
