Ran straddle packer on tubing at 2512', anchor packer at 2461', 7/8/54 swabbed. 7/7/54 treated 32 bbl. kerosene, 2,000 gals. 24 deg. refined oil with 1 lb. sand per gal. 8,000 gals. with 1-1/2 lbs. Flushed 71 bbls. crude oil. Max. injection pressure, 2600 psig. at end of flush, 2100 psig. dropping to 1100 psig. On vacuum in 3 hrs. Total injection time: 35 min. Total load oil including annulus: 454 bbls. 7/8/54 tripped packer, swabbed tubing. 7/9/54 swabbed 142 bbls. 16 hrs. 7/10 swabbed 23 bbls., pulled tubing. swabbed 117 bbls. 7/11 swabbed 81 bbls. in 8 hrs. 7/12 swabbed 91 bbls. in 8 hrs. (NET 20 BO). 7/13 swabbed 62 bbls. 7/14 swabbed 46 bbls., 7/15 swabbed 51 bbls.
