DETAILS OF WORK

On September 17, 1957 we ran 873' (27 jts) of 5 1/2" OD and 170 JK new casing as liner hung on Brown Type "C" 6-ship liner hanger & Type "B" packer (16"). Total length 873' hung from 2443' to 3316' and cemented with 35 sacks cement.

After allowing to stand 16 hours, we ran temperature survey which indicated top of cement at 2415'. Survey run by West Engineering Co.

After standing cemented 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole dry and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling operations were resumed.

Cementing was done by Benton Oil Well Cementing Co.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
