DETAILS OF WORK

WE PROPOSE TO DRILL THIS WELL AS FOLLOWS:

OBJECTIVE: Grayburg-Jackson Zone.

TOTAL DEPTH: Approximately 3110'.

CASING PROGRAM: Salt String - will set approximately 385' of 8-5/8" OD casing at top of salt and cement with 50 sacks of cement preceded by heavy mud to surface.  
Production String - will set approximately 2820' of 7" OD casing and cement with 100 sacks of cement preceded by heavy mud to surface.

ACIDIZING PROGRAM: To be determined and submitted at a later date.

METHOD OF DRILLING: Cable-tools.

DRILLING OPERATIONS TO COMMENCE: On or about February 16, 1950, with a Company owned No. 3 National Machine.

REMARKS: This unorthodox location approved by NMOCC Order No. B-7.
