## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

WE HAD A SHOW OF OIL ESTIMATED AT 5 BOPD WHICH WAS IN STRAINS OF SANDY LINE IN THE SECTION FROM 2410 TO 2440. WE SHOT THE SECTION (2410 to 40) WITH 120 QUARTS, TAMPING 25 FEET OF GRAVEL AND 10 FEET OF CALSHEAL. AFTER THE SHOT WENT OFF WE RAN 2221 FEET OF 7" CD OF 22 & 24 # USED SMLS. CASING CEMENTING SAME WITH 100 SACKS BY DENTON OIL WELL CEMENTING COMPANY. AFTER WAITING 72 HOURS WE DRILLED THE PLUG AND TEST SHOWS COMPLETE SHUT OFF. DRILLING CONTINUES. THE WELL HAS SHOWN NO APPARENT INCREASE OVER THE 5 B.O.P.D.
