DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On 5-13-50 we ran 272 feet of 8 5/8 inch casing in this well and cemented it with 50 sacks of cement. We had encountered about 10 to 12 gallons of water per hour at a depth of 255 feet. After letting cement set for 72 hours we drilled the plug and tested for water shut-off. Shut-off was complete.
