DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Per our conversation we acidized this well in two stages on the above dates with Dowell, Inc. doing the work using 5" tubing and a Sweet Packer. We gave the well 1000 gal. on Nov. 28 th and 2500 gal. on Nov 29 th. The zone acidized was from 2500 feet to 2628 feet. Before acid the well was making approximately 6 BOPD. Early tests show an increase to approximately one barrel of oil per hour.
