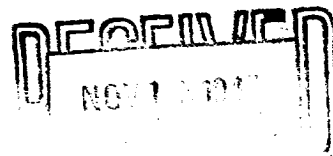


DUPLICATE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION **MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS**
