Gentlemen:

This is to advise that 140 barrels of oil have been transferred from Tenneco Oil Company's State "M" No. 4 well, located in the SW/4 NW/4, Section 21, T-17-S, R-29-E, to Tenneco's State "N" No. 1 well, located in the NW/4 SW/4 Section 27, T-17-S, R-29-E. Both of these wells are in the Grayburg Jackson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

This oil was used for the purpose of hot oiling the tubing and flowline of the State "N" No. 1 well to melt paraffin. The oil will be recovered and run to the pipeline from the State "N" No. 1 battery.
