Gentlemen:

The captioned wells have been converted to water injection wells. Commission Orders R-3069 and WFX 245 authorized Tenneco to convert the wells, providing that the tubing-casing annulus above the packer was filled with a non-corrosive fluid.

This is to advise that the tubing-casing annulus above the packer in each of the captioned wells is filled with fresh water which has been treated with chemicals to prevent corrosion of the tubing and casing. Further, sulphur dioxide gas is being injected into the injection water to scavenge the oxygen.

This information was not submitted on Form C-103, "Subsequent Report of Converting to Water Injection" and is furnished so that your records will be complete.
