DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to ~~graze~~ off perforations from 6282' to 6291' with temporary blocking material, pull tubing and perforate 5 1/2" from 6224' to 6230' and from 6236' to 6242' with 4 jets per ft.

We will re-run 2" tubing with packer and acidize new perforations with 1000 gals HCl.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
