On April 26, we ran 3014' of new seamless J55 - 4-1/2" O.D. casing and cemented with 350 sacks cement. Let set 5 days. Ran electric logs. Perforated from 2876'-2890', treated with 400 bbls. oil and 16,000 lbs. sand. Over flush with 100 bbls oil. Swabbed and blowed 500 bbls. oil back in 72 hrs. May 5 well flowed 40 bbls. oil 24 hrs. through 2" tubing.
