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OIL OR GAS SANDS OR ZONES

June 22, 1947 well was washed with 500 gallons of 20% acid using Dowell method, balled out and acidized with 2000 gallons of 20% acid using Dowell method. A leak developed in cement job and acid went behind casing. The leak was successfully shut off by squeezing with 500 gallons of 20% acid using Dowell method. Well was re-acidized July 3, 1947 from 2500 to 3086, with 2000 gallons of 20% acid using Dowell method. Production was increased from an estimated 7 BPD. to an estimated 20 BPD. July 5, 1947 well was acidized from 2900 to 3086, with 5000 gallons of 100% acid using Dowell method. Estimated production after treatment was 24 BPD.
