The original battery site and oil storage facilities were revamped along with the placement of a gas sales meter run to insure separate handling and measurement of all oil and gas produced from this well and well #3 which was located on the same lease that was also excluded from the Unit. (See Plat)

No unit production (oil or gas) goes through this battery. Well placed back on active status 8/1/73.

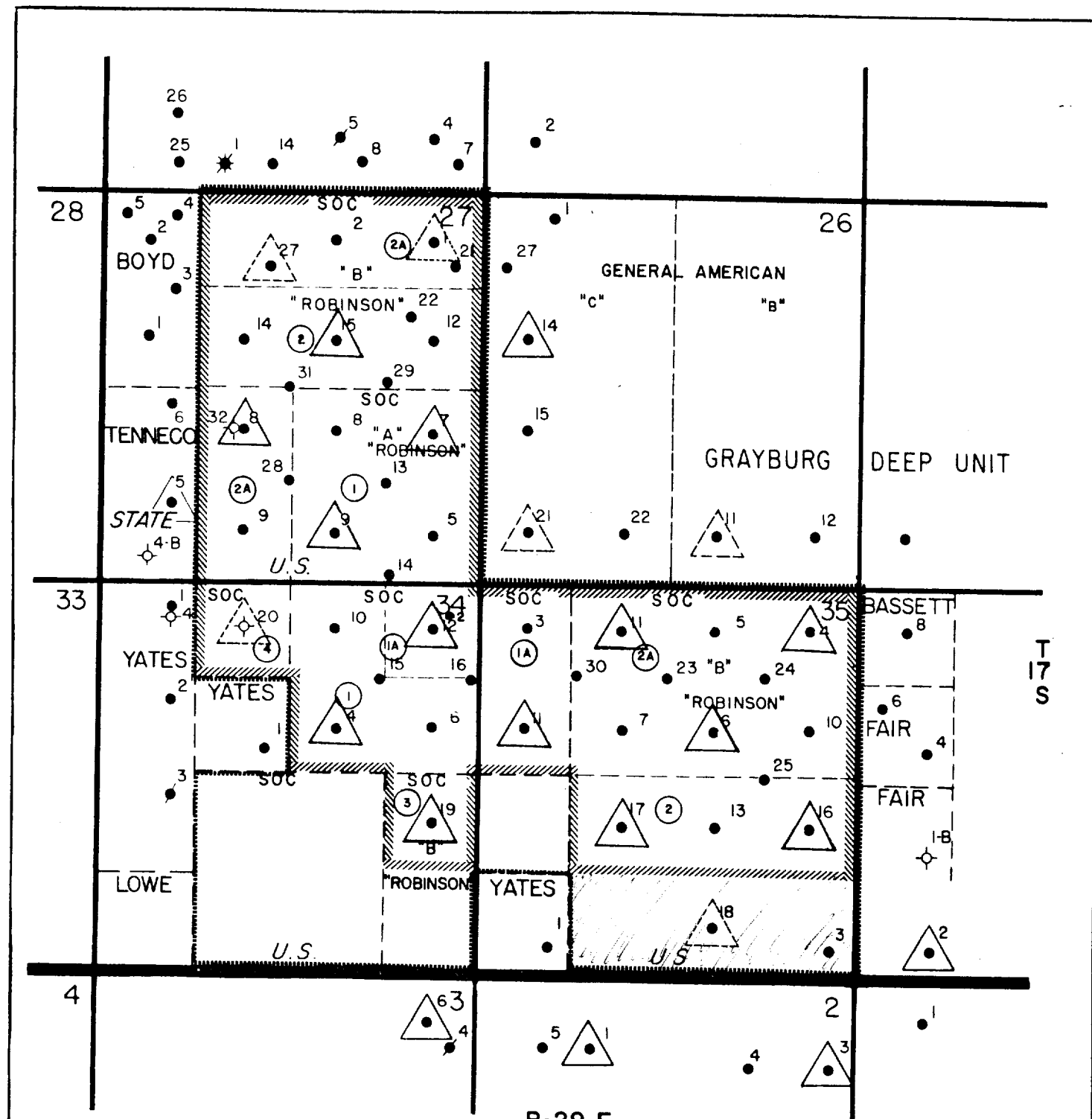
