5-29-66 Ran 3302' of 4 1/2" OD 10.5# J-55 casing and set at 3302' with 585 sacks cement. Cement circulated.
5-31-66 Wait on cement 24 hrs. Tested 4 1/2" casing at 1000# for 30 min. Tested OK. Drilled & washed cement to 3298 PBTD.
6-1-66 Ran cement bond log and perforated Loco Hills with 2 3/8" shots per foot from 2612-2618' and 2634-2657'. (58 holes)
6-2-66 Ran 2 3/8" OD tubing with Baker loc set packer set at 2581'. Swabbed 10 bbls. load oil and 2 bbls. new oil in 4 hrs.
6-3-66 Acidized Grayburg perforation 2612-2657 with 500 gal. mud acid. Max. press. 1800# at rate of .55 BPM.
6-5-66 Pulled tubing and sand-oil frac perforations 2612-2657 with 15,000 gal. refined oil and 15,000# sand. Max. press. 3350# at rate of 16 BPM.
6-6-66 Ran 2 3/8" OD tubing and set at 2581'.
6-9-66 Ran rods & pump and set pumping unit.
6-14-66 On 24 hr. potential test ending at 6:00 PM on 6-14-66, pumped Grayburg perforations 2612-2657', 60 bbls. new 34.0 Gvty. oil and 10 bbls. formation water. GOR 1860/1 Completed as an oil well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submission to the Federal and Indian land offices to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian land pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either as shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, location on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; and other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
