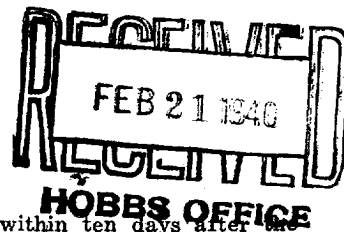

After waiting 72 hours for cement to set drilled plug and tested water shut-off with a four bailing test and found we had a complete water shut-off.
