DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was cleaned out to the Total depth of 2775' and on Oct 19, 1954 1000 gals of kerosene and 20 gals of Dowell P4 solvent were injected into the hole and left to stand overnight.

October 20, the well was treated with 10,000 gals of heavy oil and 20,000 lbs of sand through 2 1/2" tubing set at 2761'. Tubing was run with a Guiberson KV30 sucker and 11 1/2" hold down tool. Sucker set at 2500'. Well was flushed with 100 bbls of lease oil.

October 21, tubing was pulled and cleaned out started, cleanout was completed and well returned to production November 1, 1954.

Before treatment well was making an average of 2 bbls daily on gas lift. After treatment well is now making 10 bbls daily on gas lift.
