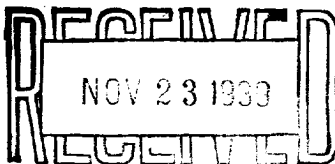

Plan to shoot well on Nov. 21, 1939 with 100 qts. of nitro-glycerin, from 2705 to 2750 feet. Shot will be tamped with 2 yards of gravel and hole loaded with oil.

Previous shot of 70 qts. on Oct. 28, 1939 did not prove effective and it is thought a heavier shot will obtain better results.
