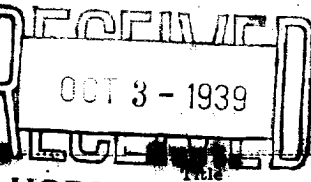

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Put Kelly-Springer plug at bottom of hole and cemented with 10 sacks.
Filled hole with mud to 2700' and cemented again with 5 sacks.
Run mud and bridge to fill up to 2700' and cemented with 5 sacks.
Then filled with mud to bottom of pipe and cemented with 10 sacks.
Then cemented surface and put up 8" pipe marker.
