DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On December 21, 1947, we ran 2650 feet of 7" OD 20# New Casing and cemented with 100 sack cement preceded by heavy mud to surface. After standing cemented for 72 hours plug was drilled on December 24, 1947, and water shut-off tested by the bailing method. Water shut-off was satisfactory and drilling operations were continued.
