On 11-5-43 pulled 2" tubing & cleaned out to T. D. 3025, then drilled

deeper to 3051' and reran tubing to circulate.

On 11-11-43 shot with 130 qts. S. N. G. from 2965-3051' & cleaned out to T. D. 3051'.

After this work was completed the well tested 88 bbls. oil in 20 hrs. through 20/64" choke w/260 MCF gas. Before this work was performed, the well tested 20 bbls. oil per day flowing by heads with 90 MCF gas daily.
