4 1/2" casing is cemented at 2795'. Open hole is from 2795 to 3001'. Well is pumping about 4 barrels water per day and no oil.

It is proposed to convert this well to water injection by running 2-3/8" O.D. upset tubing lined with either plastic or cement. A packer will be set at about 2775', and injection of water will be done below packer.

This well was authorized for injection by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order #R-4676, Case #5102, dated Nov. 20, 1973.

Instructions
