During the period Oct. 22 to Oct. 31, 1974, this well was deepened from 3042 to 3161', and pay was encountered in the Lovington Sand from 3136 to 3146'.

On December 5, 1974, well was treated below Lynes packer at 3077' with 500 gals. 15% acid + 40,000 gals. Redifrac with 24,000# of 20/40 sand and 5,000# of 10/20 sand. Treated at 4,000 to 4,400 psi. at 21.6 BPM. After treatment well pumped 11 BO + 5 BWPD. Prior to treatment well pumped 1/2 BOPD.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
