It is proposed to perform the following work to stimulate oil production:

Lovington Sand - Perforate 3173-83. Treat with 100 gallons of acid and frac with 3,000 gallons of Redi-frac + 3,000# sand.Premier Sand - Perforate 3022½, 3026-32 and 3044-56. Treat with 600 gallons of acid and frac with 10,000 gallons of Redi-frac + 10,000# sand.Grayburg Sands - Perforate 2980-86 and treat with 150 gallons of acid + 4,000 gallons of Redi-frac + 4,000# sand.

Perforate 2916-30 and treat with 150 gallons acid + 6,000 gallons Redi-frac + 6,000# sand.

Halliburton straddle packers will be used to control treatments.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
